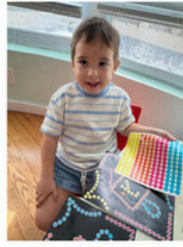

Message from the Menahel

For as long as yidden have been lighting the menorah, our chachamim have debated what has become known as the Bais Yosef's question. There was enough oil to light the menorah one day and miraculously the oil lasted eight days. The question is, the miracle was only seven days. So why do we celebrate Chanukah for eight days? One answer that always resonated with me, is that we need to appreciate even the things that we expect. For seven days, we thank Hashem for the miracle of the oil lasting beyond what it should have. But the very fact that the oil lit for one day is also a reason lehodos ulehallel-to thank and sing praise. That is the eighth day (Zos Chanukah). We shouldn't take for granted any of the endless blessings that Hashem gives us. Our health, our families, our parnassah, and the things that we take as a given, are all gifts from Hashem to be appreciated. This Chanukah, let's all appreciate everything and everyone that we have.
