Message from the Menahel

The Baal Haturim explains that the reason Moshe Rabbeinu's name is not in Parshas Tetzaveh, is because next week in Ki Sisa, he tells Hashem; "Forgive the Jewish people for the egel hazahav, or erase my name from Your Torah." His omission in Tetzaveh is a fulfillment of that curse.

The Vilna Goan explains that Tetzaveh was chosen because Moshe's yartzheit/birthday almost always falls out during the week of Tetzaveh. It is hard to understand why we would remember Moshe Rabbeinu being erased from the Torah on his birthday/yartzehit. Shouldn't that be the time to highlight the good things? You would think that Tetzaveh would be the last parsha to discuss this! Moshe's removal from Tetzaveh is the greatest testament of his selfless life. Moshe Rabbeinu loved and was so dedicated to Klal Yisroel that he was ready to be erased to save them.

This is also the message of Purim. Mordechai tells Esther to go to the king. Risk your life to save others! They also lost each other **כאשר אבדתי אבדתי**. This is also the opposite of Amalek, who is so dedicated to harming others- even at his own peril. May we be zoche to follow in the ways of Moshe, Mordechai, and Esther and to live selflessly, doing whatever we can for others.
