# This week in Nursery...

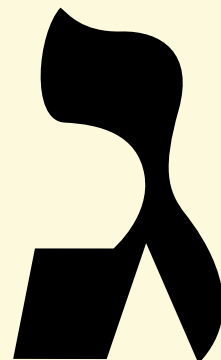
**Dear Parents,**

Wishing everyone a wonderful Shabbos!**

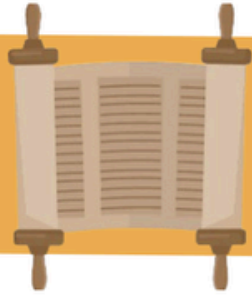

# Q A One-Man Voter Survey

David works for Mr. Katz, one of our

local town councilmen. I recently met  
 supermarket, and we began chatting. He asked  
 me, "What do you hear around town about Mr.  
 Katz? Are people saying anything negative?" I  
 presumed that he wanted to know so that he could  
 help Mr. Katz address any issues that might work  
 against him in the elections that are coming up  
 later this year. So I mentioned that I had heard

a few complaints. For one, people say that he  
 doesn't respond to emails in a timely fashion.  
 I have also heard that it takes a while for  
 him to act upon reports of potholes, broken  
 traffic lights, unplowed streets, and the  
 like. After I gave David all this information, I  
 started to wonder—why *did* he ask me for  
 it? Was I allowed to answer him?

## What's the Psak?

Do you know the halachah?

**A Yes.**  
 He asked you, so the transgression is his.

**B Yes.**  
 David will likely use the information to benefit Mr. Katz.

**C No.**  
 Both you and David made a mistake. David didn't clarify that he is asking *l'toeles*, and Gershon answered without knowing if there was really a *to'eles*.

## Why Do You Want to Know?

In our day-to-day lives, we often need to ask people about others and rely on their answers so that we can make more informed decisions. This often falls under the umbrella of *to'eles*, because our intention is to use the information to protect ourselves (such as from an unsuitable *shidduch* or business partner), not to malign the subject.

However, when we ask for information *l'toeles*, we have to *say so clearly*. If a person doesn't explain that it is for a constructive purpose, the person being asked thinks that the questioner is simply asking him to share negative information—with no *to'eles*—so answering would be *loshon hora*.<sup>1</sup> The questioner violates the prohibition against "placing a stumbling block in front of the blind."<sup>2</sup>

David's mistake was that he did not explain why he wanted the information about Mr. Katz. Without that clarity, he led Gershon to speak *loshon hora* without a valid *to'eles*.

In addition, the person being asked must clarify why he is being asked—to ensure that anything derogatory that he says has a constructive purpose.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, Gershon's mistake was that, before saying anything negative about Mr. Katz, he should have asked David why he wanted the information.

**Answer:** The halachah is C.

*l'chaim* with you tonight."

Tzvi sat with the rabbi, drank a *l'chaim*, and talked proudly about the bar mitzvah boy.

"Listen, Tzvi, tomorrow night, you'll

get loads of *brachos* for your son, and they will all go up to *Shamayim*. Meanwhile, your father will be crying bitter tears. Those will also rise to *Shamayim*. There'll be great confusion. This is the time to make peace."

Tzvi realized that the rabbi was right. But his wife had been very hurt by the situation. She would also need to forgive.

Rabbi Scheinberg spoke to her. "You know, I've been waiting for fourteen years to have another child," he told her. "Could you make peace as a *zechus* for my wife and me?"

After a moment, she answered, "I can't say no to that."

Tzvi went to his father; the two men embraced in tears. And exactly one year later, Rabbi and Mrs. Scheinberg welcomed a new baby into the world.

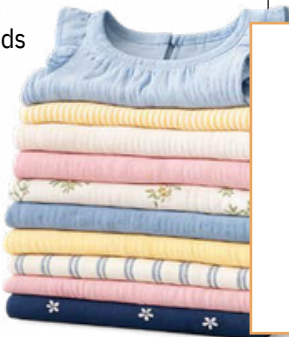
